Dr. Mostafa Ghalwash is a respected leader in healthcare quality and patient safety in Saudi Arabia and internationally. He holds a Master of Medical Management from the University of Southern California and several key certifications, including CPHQ, TQM, and Six Sigma Black Belt.

As Chief of Quality at Saudi German Health, Dr. Ghalwash has led major improvements in quality and safety across multiple hospitals. Under his leadership, the organisation became the first in Saudi Arabia to receive ICHOM accreditation and successfully implemented the country's first Value-Based Healthcare Framework, collecting over 30,000 Patient-Reported Outcome Measures (PROMs).

Previously, as Director of Hospital Accreditation at the Saudi Central Board for Accreditation of Healthcare Institutions (CBAHI), he led national programs like AMAN, helping hospitals improve safety and meet high-quality standards.

Dr. Ghalwash is also an international surveyor with ACHS International and a certified trainer with the American Society for Quality (ASQ). He has trained hundreds of professionals and supported hospitals in meeting global healthcare standards.

His work has earned him national recognition, including helping Dr. Soliman Fakeeh Hospital become the first private hospital in Saudi Arabia to win the King Abdulaziz Excellence Award. Dr. Ghalwash is known for his dedication to continuous improvement, patient-centered care, and advancing healthcare quality across the region.
